The Jericho Conservation Commission is planning a clean-up day at Mills Riverside Park and we are contemplating the purchase of trees through the Winooski Valley Park District to shade out the Japanese knotweed there.

Forestry work on the Gateway property is beginning to take shape. We are doing some very small patch cuts to help the trees most crucial to wildlife. We expect the project to be completed this summer.
