As the year draws to a close JULT will be sending out a letter asking our members (and former members) to renew their membership. We hope you will continue to support us as we do important land conservation work. While we await new opportunities for conservation we are trying to maximize the money we currently have. We are considering revising our investment strategy to make sure our money works as hard as we do.

Our logging operation at Gateway/Wolfrun Natural Area is going well. On the other side of the tree equation, the silver maples planted at Mills Riverside Park to shade out the Japanese Knotweed are in very good shape. We have a new contact at BRMS who is overseeing the school's participation in that project.
