Over the years, JULT has received some stock donations. Upon a motion duly made and seconded, the board agreed that it was time to sell our holdings.

The draft conservation easement for Tomasi has been sent to the Underhill Select Board which is also working on an interim management plan. We are in discussion with two Jericho landowners about possible conservation projects.

Two different groups will be working to eradicate invasive barberry at Kikas Valley Farm this summer and the board approved the necessary expenditures. There was discussion about repairing a road at Wolfrun Natural Area but the board did not make a determination on whether or not to do so.

We have tentatively scheduled a fall wildflower walk with Liz Thompson for September 19 but it may be cancelled depending on the state of the pandemic.
