Several board members met with representatives from several different agencies including UVM Extension, Partners for Fish and Wildlife, Vermont Agency of Agriculture, Food and Markets, National Resources Conservation Service, Vermont Housing and Conservation Board, and Vermont Department of Environmental Conservation, regarding erosion control on the Kikas Valley Pasture. There may be Conservation Reserve Enhancement Program grants available to help us with water quality improvements issues.

The Mobbs Committee made a great presentation in front of the Jericho Select Board regarding permanently conserving the property. The hope is that they will put the question on the Town Meeting ballot.
