Steve Hagenbuch of Audubon Vermont is coordinating with our new forester Michael Brown to incorporate bird friendly practices in the new forest management plan for Kikas Valley Farm. The board vote to authorize a timber harvest on the property as part of the plan. During our forester's review of the property, he found six unauthorized tree stands. Although JULT allows hunting at Kikas Valley Farm, the installation of tree stands is prohibited and we will erect signage that says so. It was noted that there have been a lot of cross-country skiers at Kikas Valley Farm.

The board eagerly anticipates the Town Meeting Day vote on the conservation of Mobbs Farm. It is an advisory vote but the hope is that the Select Board will follow the will of the voters.
