Will Dunkley gave a presentation on the pros and cons of using Glyphosate to combat the invasive Japanese barberry at Kikas Valley Farm. He uses a formula which doesn't include some of the more toxic elements in commercial products like Roundup. The board is undecided on how to proceed and several members will do additional research. Will thinks that stump application would be too time/labor intensive and is proposing air application. Other options are cutting and/or fire but they would require multiple attempts. If we go the Glyphosate route, the work would be done in the fall.
